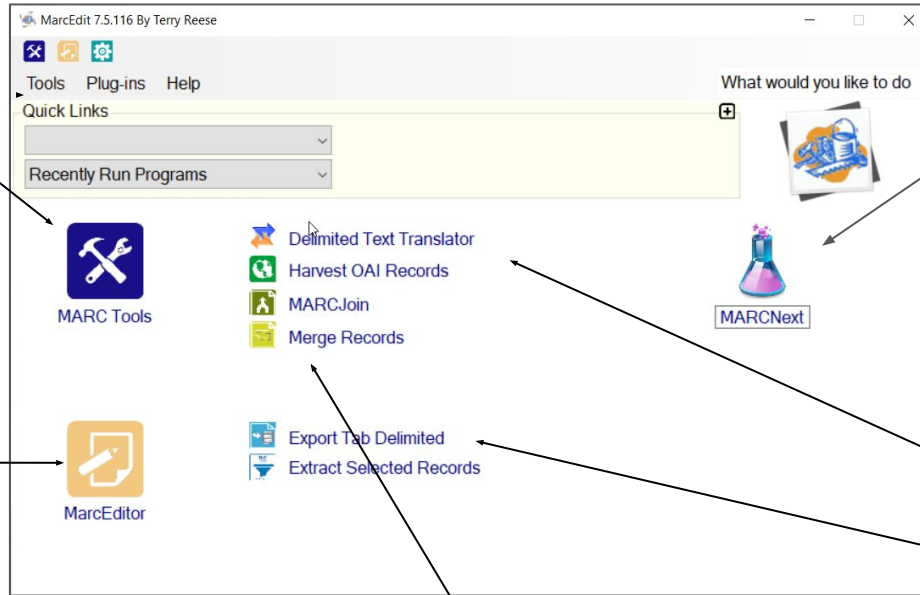

MarcEdit tools

Suite of tools for manipulating MARC files

MarcEditor, a program for making edits to MARC records



MARC Next

Tools for translating Excel to MARC and back

Merge Records, a tool for transferring fields to create a combined file

Uses

Incoming Records

1. Sets of vendor-supplied records (e-resources, leased books, etc.)
2. Batches of records from bibliographic utilities (OCLC: WCM, batch searches, exported .dat files; z39.50; Skyriver)

Output Records

1. Your ILS can't easily make the types of changes you want or need
2. You want to incorporate additional data from a spreadsheet or updated set of records

Working with Bib records

Analysis/QC for a file of MARC records (MarcEditor Reports)

- Are they complete? Valid structure? MARC errors?
- What material types are present?
- Do access points match the LC authority file?

Editing MARC records/Quality enhancements

- Validate/Link headings
- RDA helper
- Edit/Add/Build fields

Reviewing and improving an incoming file

Test file 1

- Reports
 - Field count
 - MARC validation
 - **Validate Headings**
- (Marc Next: Link Identifiers)
- File: Select Records for Edit
 - Display field 008
 - Search: `.{32}[1fs]`
 - Use Regular Expressions
- Tools: Build New Field
 - `=099 \${a}Fiction {100$a.substring(0,5)}`
- Tools: Edit subfield
 - Field: 099
 - Field data: ,
 - Remove Text

Enhancing catalog records

Test file 2 & 3

- Export records from your ILS
- Extract control numbers & batch search current (fuller) iterations from bibliographic utility
- Merge Records (carry over current access points, etc.)
- Run *Tools: RDA Helper* in MarcEditor, compile into MARC
- Re-load into ILS

Authority records

Test file 4

Add “open” date 400 fields to name ARs with closed dates

- Copy Field Data (1)
 - Source field 100
 - Find in Field: (\\$d\d{4}-)(\d{4})(.*)
 - Destination Field: 400
 - Field Data: \$1\$3\$wnnea
 - [x] Use Regular Expressions
- Copy Fields Data (1)
 - Ditto, but source field 400
